
The Italian National Institute of Statistics

- ▶ Istat is a public research organization and the main producer of official statistics in the service of citizens and policy-makers.
- Since 1926, it has the institutional task of collecting, processing and disseminating demographic, economic, social and environmental data on the situation of the country.
- Lts activity constitutes a fundamental lever for the exercise of democracy

 - Administrative registers
 - ☐ Big data





The paradox of contemporary statistics

- Growing demand for accessible, timely and integrated statistical information
- Reduction of statistical burden on respondents
- Containment of public spending





Istat's decisions for greater data quality

- ➤ Enhancement of administrative registers and integration between different sources
- Dissemination through the creation of information systems
- ➤ Investment in new research and development projects, in particular, on innovative sources (Big data, Smart statistics)

Our experience

- Consolidated tradition in welcoming students in training
- ☐ More than 20 affiliated Universities (6 EMOS)
- Applications constantly growing in recent years. About 20% coming from EMOS programmes.
- ☐ 60% of applications accepted

Our training offer (1/2)

- ✓ To orientate: collect reasoned and motivated applications;
- ✓ 70 thematic paths in 6 macro-areas Statistics, IT, Administrative, Communication, Organization, Administration, Transversal and specific disciplinary sectors;
- ✓ For each internship: title and summary description, expected commitment, prerequisites, technical equipment required, tutoring options (English and remote), number of students admitted, implementation methods, etc.





Our training offer (2/2)

- √ 45 statistical internships, core area of the Institute
- ✓ Sub-areas and internships of particular interest:
 - Data Science:
 - 001: Artificial intelligence for improving processes and statistical outputs;
 - 002: Covid-19's impact on official statistics;
 - 003: ASI satellite data processing through Machine Learning and Deep Learning techniques
 - Geospatial statistics:
 - ❖ 044: Smart specialisation areas: an analysis of the main territorial differences;
 - Methods and techniques for statistical surveys:
 - 029: Innovative methods and AI techniques for data collection;
 - ❖ 030: Confronting Google Places and Open Street Maps with a view to Official Statistics



How to apply

- Master's degree students;
- Collection of applications: from 10 AM,15th octobre 2024 until 12 AM (noon), 31st of octobre 2024 (by SPID); by Moodle platform only for foreign students
- □ Curriculum vitae et studiorum in European format + Certicate of bachelor's degree + Certicate of exams of the current course of study;
- Preference for a single internship with motivation;
- □ Selection of applications: the selection of applications will end by the end of November
- 2024;
- ☐ Feedback email (for both outcomes);
- ☐ Instructions to activate the internship: mid-December 2024.
- □ DSS students with no SPID (non-Italian resident) can submit documents using this Moodle site: https://elearning.uniroma1.it/course/view.php?id=19025 (key: IstatInternship)

Activation of the internship and feedback

- Training project in agreement with both tutors, following the procedures of activation for each University;
- □ Period and organizational aspects for carrying out internships in agreement with Istat tutors;
- Mandatory safety course, 8 hours;
- ☐ The administrative and coordination aspects are handled by **Istat Internship Area**;
- ☐ At the end of the internship: final report on the experience.
